LIVE THE LIFE

“Come, follow me” is an invitation to embody Jesus collectively.

John 13:34-35

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

1 Corinthians 12:12

Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ.





LTL COLLECTIVELY

GATHERING

The practice of gathering and being closely associated with other Jesus-followers engaging in common practices together.

Hebrews 10:24-25

“... not giving up meeting together ... but encouraging one another ...”

Matthew 16:18 - Ekklesia

“... I will build my church ...”

Acts 2:42 - Koinonia

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.





LTL COLLECTIVELY

GATHERING

Gather with a holy expectation that God is going to speak, move, and fill us.

Acts 4:31

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.





LTL COLLECTIVELY

GATHERING

Gather to
love God,
declare God as worthy,
experience God's empowering presence,
and respond to God in worship.

John 4:23

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.






LTL COLLECTIVELY

GENEROSITY

The practice of giving to those who are in need and willingly sharing resources with the church.

Acts 2:44-45

All the believers were together and had everything in common. 45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.



LTL COLLECTIVELY

GENEROSITY

Matthew 6:2-4

2 “So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. 3 But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, 4 so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

Matthew 23:23

23 “Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former.




LTL COLLECTIVELY

SERVICE

Intentionally using spiritual gifts, goods and strengths - to help someone in a non-transactional way without the expectation of reciprocation.

Matthew 20:29

just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.



LTL COLLECTIVELY

SERVICE

Galatians 5:13

You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

1 Peter 4:10-11

10 Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. 11 If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.



LTL COLLECTIVELY

HOSPITALITY

The practice of creating an environment in which others feel belonging and value moving them from stranger to guest to friend to family.

1 Peter 4:9


Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters. 2 Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.
