LIVE THE LIFE


“Come, follow me.” - Jesus

(Matthew 16:24, Luke 9:23, John 12:26, Matthew 4:19,
Luke 9:57-62, John 10:27, Mark 8:34, Matthew 19:21, John 8:12)

- **Following Jesus is a life to live.**
- **Following Jesus is to live the life of a disciple, with the intention of becoming more like Him and living like He taught us to live.**

Living the life missionally is intentionally, relationally building bridges to those who aren't following Jesus.

Word and Deed.

LIVE THE LIFE

Matthew 4:19

“Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.”²⁰ At once they left their nets and followed him.

Matthew 5:16

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 28:18-20

Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”



LTL MISSIONALLY

PROCLAMATION

The practice of preaching the gospel through use of words.

Mark 16:15

He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."





LTL MISSIONALLY

PROCLAMATION

Proclamation can happen by having gracious, gospel-centered conversations with people.

Mark 2:15

While Jesus was having dinner at Levi's house, many tax collectors and sinners were eating with him and his disciples, for there were many who followed him.

GATHERING

**Gather to
love God,
declare God as worthy,
experience God's empowering presence,
and respond to God in worship.**

John 4:23

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.






LTL MISSIONALLY

JUSTICE

The practice of giving people what they are due - as those created by God in the image of God for God's purposes.

Matthew 23:23

LTL MISSIONALLY

MERCY

Practicing kindness and concern for people, especially those who are in serious need.

Matthew 23:23
